However, the middle-aged people are not popular Restricted by various moral and responsibility in real life, the Internet has become a catharsis channel for middle-aged people under long-term pressure and can not be solved, resulting in improper speech and other problems [2]. The rule of law governance of the Internet can not only enhance people's legal awareness to a great extent, but also spread the awareness of "the Internet is not a place outside the law" to the netizens' consciousness, so that netizens can actively restrict their own behavior, so as to build a good network environment.

### 3. The Way to Build the Rule of Law Internet

(1) Using Internet platform to establish credit mechanism

The reason why so many netizens do not pay enough attention to the network environment of the Internet lies in the fact that netizens think that there are so many people on the Internet that they can not bring themselves to justice even if they make improper remarks. In view of this situation, the Internet platform can establish a credit mechanism, supplemented by the real name system. In the network era, we should actively apply the technical advantages of the Internet, expand the scope of social credit information, and enhance the role of social credit mechanism in social governance. Courts at all levels can actively

cooperate with major platforms, such as Taobao, Tencent and other Internet work. For citizens with low credit scores on the platform, they can carry out credit punishment methods, so as to give full play to the deterrence of network legalization; for the dishonest behavior of dishonest people, the application of dishonest people in wine shops, finance, rental housing and other networks should be subject to comprehensive restrictions to promote the dishonest owners To make up for the dishonest behavior and restore the social credit. In fact, from the current situation, Alipay, Taobao, WeChat and other widely used network platforms have been trying to introduce credit mechanism. I believe that with the support of many network platforms, social credit will be improved, and at the same time, it can also promote social harmony and enhance social trust.

#### (2) Perfect laws and regulations, create a good network environment

Due to the early development of the Internet, people in China did not pay attention to the negative impact of the Internet on the public. From the current situation, it is difficult to standardize the Internet environment in China. There are three reasons: first, the geographical scope is relatively wide; secondly, the number of netizens is huge; finally, the characteristic of anonymity. Although more and more network platforms require real name system, it is not linked with face recognition or fingerprint authentication at the same time. Therefore, it is common that the real name does not match with the person himself. These factors have greatly promoted the legalization of the Internet Difficulties. In addition, the government does not pay attention to the construction of the rule of law in the network environment is also a more important reason. Therefore, in order to create a good network environment and ensure the rule of law of the Internet, we should improve the relevant laws and regulations, let the network police constantly improve the network environment under the condition of having laws to abide by, slowly promote the health of the network environment, and ensure the security of the network environment.

#### (3) Establish and enrich the concept of Internet legalization

Before the rule of law governance of the Internet, we must take the correct concept of the rule of law as the guidance, combined with the basic national conditions of our country and the current situation of the Internet, we should actively change the traditional concept of Internet rule of law. First of all, it is necessary to establish the concept of state power control. The governance of the Internet environment by governments at all levels is not only the embodiment of the normal exercise of power by the state, but also the establishment of corresponding supervision departments to avoid the abuse of power. Secondly, the basic concept of fairness and justice should be established. In the construction of the rule of law of the Internet, the purpose is to purify the network environment, stabilize the social order and protect the Internet ring Finally, it is necessary to establish a people-oriented management concept. In the process of Internet governance by law, we should fully consider that the governance object is Chinese citizens, not "virtual netizens". Therefore, in the management process, we should be people-oriented and improve the compliance of Internet users to the rule of law [4]. Only by establishing and enriching the concept of Internet legalization can we ensure the rationality and scientificity of Internet legalization measures to the maximum extent.

## 4. Conclusion

To sum up, the network is not a place outside the law. In view of the current situation of the Internet in China, relevant departments should clarify the necessity of legalization of the Internet, so as to take effective measures to legalize the Internet environment, ensure the safety of the Internet, and make Internet users realize the importance of knowing and abiding by the law within the scope of the Internet.
