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Research on the Construction of Online and Offline Mixed College English Clubs

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Abstract

The development of Internet technology has made the advantages of the "Internet + education" mode more and more prominent, and has also broadened the time, space and conditions of college club activities. 3. Problems Existing in the College English Clubs

3.1. Lack of Material Conditions and Hardware Sites

3.2. Backward and Inefficient Management Mechanism

Finally, the content construction of current community activities still has not done a perfect connection between online and offline. 3.4. Unsustainable Development of the Club

In the final analysis, the sustainable development of the club lies in whether it can always adhere to its own characteristics, whether it can keep pace with the times, and continue to innovate and develop. It will inevitably fail to attract the attention and energy investment of members of the club, so it will inevitably be eliminated by the torrent of the times.

4. Advantages of Online and Offline Mixed College English Clubs

4.1. Convenience of Online Activities

The online and offline mixed college English club is a new club activity mode formed based on the development of network technology in the age of Internet communication. Different from the development model of traditional campus clubs in the past, the mixed online and offline mode can effectively overcome various hardware resource limitations and shortage of funds, and use the advantages of media such as communication and communication in the new era to greatly expand the opportunities for English learning and communication. The prominent feature of online and offline mixed teaching is the combination of virtual and reality, the use of network construction to effectively make up for the social activities affected by the lack of funds, and the use of online and offline interaction to effectively overcome the limited space of the venue^[2]. The first-hand information is passed to every member inside, avoiding the constant communication caused by the lag of news dissemination^[3]. For some major decisions, such as club change, personnel change, group activities, etc., there is no need to use the previous offline show of hands to vote, and online voting can be conducted directly within the group. At present, some college English clubs have gradually started to establish their own network management groups, through which they can complete decision-making and discussion tasks, and finally implement them in practice directly offline, which not only saves time but also ensures the overall completion of activities.

4.3. Diversity of Content

The mixed mode of online and offline can effectively expand the content types of English club activities. The reason why the online and offline mixed mode can effectively ensure the sustainable development of college English clubs is that it is of great help in promoting classmates' friendship. Self-promotion with superior resources is able to achieve better, faster and have more stable community growth.

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5. Construction Strategies of Online and Offline Mixed College English Clubs

5.1. Expanding Learning Resources Online and Completing Learning Discussions Offline

Online and offline mixed societies is able to make full use of the information advantages of the current era, continuously explore online learning resources available online, share and discuss, and achieve common progress of all offline members. Compared with the traditional offline learning mode, online learning resources have a great advantage in both type and quantity. For those clubs that do not have many English learning resources in their own schools, an online learning resource collection group can be set up within the club to be responsible for statistics of students' learning needs, and then use the Internet to complete the collection and utilization of data. Online networks can not only provide a variety of learning content, but also constantly open up students' horizons through new cultural trends. For example, offline English movie viewing activities can be held regularly in college English clubs. The person in charge of the club collects the movie viewing needs of students in advance, and then collects movie resources on the Internet. In this way, regular movie viewing activities not only improve college students' own English vocabulary and oral English, but also the philosophy of life and expressive techniques conveyed by the movie will continuously improve students' aesthetic cognition level.

5.2. Using Network Classification to Manage and Improve Service Mechanism

Only by continuously integrating the feelings of the community can the management of the club be more warm and humane. And at the same time, the institutional construction cannot be relaxed. The members can make full use of the characteristics of modern technology to improve the internal management mechanism of the club and realize the balanced and comprehensive development of the club.

5.3. Combining Online Virtual Activities with Practical Activities

It is an important issue that needs to be paid attention to in the development of English clubs to activate the atmosphere of the club and realize the balance of entertainment and education.
