They can become idols in the hearts of the people, not only because of their advanced deeds and great contributions, but also because the people need them to become symbols of spiritual guidance and goals to strive for.

In contrast, in recent years, although there are leaders such as Hao Wanshan and Deng Tietao, most of their popularity only stays in the circle of TRADITIONAL Chinese medicine. Causes of this phenomenon I think there are two aspects, on the one hand is the social reasons, because the level of Chinese medicine is now intermingled with the good and the bad, the patient encountered a quack delayed treatment, it is not desirable to treat the doctor looking for Chinese medicine, this is the consequences of discrediting the people have to speak; On the other hand, traditional Chinese medicine doctors are more influenced by the ancient traditional culture, and believe that people should hide their brightness and cultivate obscurity, and often do not choose to show their teeth and put themselves in the center of public opinion.
