3. Characteristics of The Traditional College Teaching Method

3.1. Advantages of The Traditional College Teaching Method

3.2. Disadvantages of The Traditional College Teaching Method

The first is that teachers' concepts are more backward, more emphasis on teaching content in the classroom, no innovative teaching methods, and a lack of reflection in teaching. At the same time, some teachers only for the sake of teaching tasks, no in-depth communication with students, poor ability to organize knowledge, ignoring the individual differences in student learning, not to mention the role of meaning construction in teaching. Secondly, students have stereotyped thinking and poor learning motivation. In the process of English teaching, students only passively accept knowledge and do not fully express their own views. In addition, teachers seldom provide opportunities for answering and discussing questions, which leads to some students not thinking deeply about the teaching knowledge and not connecting the old and new knowledge effectively. Finally, due to the large class teaching, speaking and writing cannot be one-on-one, personalized teaching, so some teachers ignore the importance of this teaching method is also known as "mute English", college students cannot open their mouths to speak English in the classroom, the practicality of the language has been completely ignored, and the workplace is the most extensive use of the spoken language, the teaching mode and the real needs of the workplace are out of touch with the university. The disconnection between the teaching mode and the real workplace demand indirectly leads to a significant reduction in the competitiveness of graduates' employment.

4. Characteristics of The Interactive College Teaching Method

Interaction is a concept introduced into the field of teaching and learning from social psychology. It is the process by which two or more people communicate their feelings to each other, convey information and have an impact on both parties. At the same time, interaction requires that both parties must have an interest in communication and focus on receiving or expressing information that interests the speaker or listener. First of all, the "interactive"

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teaching in the university classroom emphasizes the interaction between teachers and students, especially the student-centered teaching mode that aims at developing students' communicative competence, guiding accompanying and encouraging students to express themselves. It also creates a teaching situation in which teachers and students interact with each other, with the Internet and with society, promotes the teaching process, breaks down the traditional barriers to teaching that are limited by time, place and space, extends the teaching scene and realizes the dialectical unity of teaching and learning.

4.1. Advantages of Interactive College Teaching Method

First of all, college students are faced with the problem of employment, and now the most scarce in the workplace is the oral talent, communication is the most important part of the work, interactive teaching mode can improve students' speaking and writing ability, enhance the competitiveness of college students' employment, and is conducive to the promotion of quality education. Secondly, the teaching mode pays more attention to the practical and social aspects of English teaching, decentralizes the teacher's dominant role in teaching again, and students get the opportunity to learn independently, which is conducive to stimulating students' interest in learning, and the Internet and multimedia equipment, to understand and create a specific industry environment. At the same time, interactive teaching can target individual students, understand the students' learning progress and status, develop personalized learning plan, personalized education is satisfied. Finally, interactive teaching is a teaching method based on the comprehensive development of listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. It emphasizes that in the teaching process, the teacher's function as a carrier of knowledge and a medium is amplified, and through a variety of teaching activities, the teacher and the students make their own development and progress together.

4.2. Disadvantages of Interactive College Teaching Method

Based on China's special situation and huge population, and the current education model in China is still mostly test-based education, which requires teachers to transfer the knowledge and examination skills to students as the pursuit of the goal. Interactive teaching is a mode of learning in which students are guided and accompanied by teachers to find the results by themselves, and this method is not applicable to all subjects. Secondly, China's teaching resources are unevenly distributed, and the educational resources and teacher quality of the top institutions are significantly higher than those of other ordinary institutions. The interactive teaching mode requires a high level of teacher strength, and ordinary institutions are unable to meet this demand and the corresponding supporting facilities. Finally, the main teaching body in most schools today is still the teacher, and the metamorphosis of the main body from teacher to student is a long process that requires social acceptance and the awakening of the public's traditional concepts of education as well as the support of the school.

5. Three Way of Interactive

There are three effective way to practice and enhance the effectiveness of interactive education, and they respectively propose requirements to teachers and students from different perdpectives.

5.1. Interaction between People and People

Within the teacher, there are a total of two roles, student and teacher. Therefore, it can be subdivided into interactions between students and interactions between students and teachers. First of all the forms of interaction between students include but are not limited to: group discussions, speeches, debates, presentations, questions, and other forms. Take group discussion as an example, in the interactive teaching mode, the teacher first plays the audio of

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the text and then puts forward the questions according to the text, the students are divided into groups for discussion and each group sends a representative to summarize the group's analytical ideas and methods. During the discussion, the teacher should participate in the discussion of each group, understand the status and progress of each group, and play the role of supervision and guidance. The teacher then guides the students through the discussion, not giving answers, but providing clues to the answers and guiding the students to find the answers themselves. This interactive mode of teaching allows answers to emerge from strife and debate, and knowledge to be understood and utilized in the process of construction. Second, the interaction between students and teachers. Forms of interaction between teachers and students include, but are not limited to, lectures, questions, after-class assignments, prompts, discussions, and other forms. Taking speech as an example, teachers can prepare topics related to the content of the class before the class and assign them in the form of after-class homework, so that students can prepare a speech about them in advance, for example,

- 1. what is your favorite animals?
- 2. Do you think it is reasonable for sacrificing animal habitats for economic development?
- 3. Explain the advantages and disadvantages in protecting environment?

Ensure that students speak on each topic, and then the teacher will comment and introduce the topic of the paper. This method can "warm up" the content of the class, through the students' own thinking and interaction with the teacher, can stimulate the students' interest in learning, want to explore the theme of this paper. At the same time, the use of the method of speech, so that students participate in teaching activities, the teacher plays the role of a listener, observing the students' speech and behavior, and timely praise the students, and to follow the good guidance, to cultivate the "output" of the oral ability to enhance the students' comprehensive English language skills.

5.2. Interaction between People and Internet

First of all, China has fully entered the Internet era, and teachers in all colleges and universities should fully utilize online educational resources and multimedia equipment to update and expand their teaching methods and activities. For example, teachers can combine various online courses to match their offline teaching and include the online course scores in the assessment of the final semester grades, so that students will pay attention to the learning of the online English classroom. Secondly, nowadays there are enough online resources, when explaining reading, teachers can adopt the scenario teaching method, use multimedia equipment to play relevant audio-visual materials, try to create teaching situations related to real life and real language activities, reasonably combine with online resources to stimulate the students' learning interest, which will help the learning interest to digest, understand and absorb the target language. And in terms of teaching content, teachers can collect a huge amount of electronic materials through the Internet to supplement students with relevant background knowledge in the form of video, pictures and audio, a process that not only expands the teachers' knowledge base, but also supplements students' knowledge of the culture, literature, history and emotional needs behind the Western countries where English is the native language, expands students' learning space and realizes the two-way relationship between teachers and the Internet and students' two-way interaction with the Internet. Finally, as English lecturers in universities basically major in English or Business English, they know little about specialties other than non-language, and they have no understanding of some specific industry terminology and industry environments, which leads to a disconnect between the teaching objectives of universities and industry needs, and the practicality is drastically cut down. Teachers through the major authoritative catechism platform, so that students look for their own corresponding related industry English to learn professional English, and combined

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with the offline basic English, maximize the educational nature of the Internet, enhance the students' employment competitiveness.

5.3. Interaction between People and Society

Take the business English major as an example, this major belongs to the language category, which requires a strong professional sensitivity to English and business industry, and needs to cultivate compound talents. The specialized courses carried out by the university cannot satisfy the cultivation of these talents, and it is necessary to extend the teaching space, interact with the society, and understand and learn the working ability required in the real workplace. Teachers can apply to the university to utilize the time inside and outside the classroom and the summer and winter vacations to arrange students' English practice and social practice activities, and set up foreign trade practice classes to exercise students' professional application ability and social adaptability. At the same time, corresponding courses synchronized with social needs should be carried out, such as business negotiation, interpreting courses, crosscultural communication, international business law, business writing and translation courses, so that the professional knowledge learned by the students can be applied to specific industry situations, and this kind of immersive teaching method interacting with the society can better enable them to make flexible use of the professional knowledge they have learned, and further improve and perfect the basic and professional skills of the students. and professional skills. Secondly, the university campus is also a small "society", teachers can organize and encourage their students to actively participate in a variety of English competitions and activities, such as English Speech Contest, English Debate Contest, Campus English Song Contest and so on, to create an English atmosphere, to explore personal potential, develop independent thinking ability and practical use of English. The students will be able to develop their potential, independent thinking ability and the ability to utilize English in practice. Through a series of activities and social practice, students interact with the society continuously, enhance their social adaptability, train their professional knowledge, break the time and place constraints of teaching in the traditional mode of teaching, extend the teaching space, and help to cultivate compound talents in the new era. For English majors need to learn English in the interaction with the society, and for non-English majors need to strengthen the interaction with the society to understand what kind of compound talents are needed in their own specialty.

6. Significance of The Interactive Teaching Method

6.3. Breaking Down of Time and Space Restrictions

The traditional teaching mode is limited to the classroom and class time, the specific application of knowledge and students' extracurricular time are neglected, and only filled in the form of after-school homework, the flexibility and efficiency of teaching is limited. Interactive teaching breaks the time and space limitations, using multimedia and the Internet to extend the teaching platform and scene, teachers can use a variety of network educational resources and software to expand the teaching content, supplement extracurricular knowledge, realize the interaction between students and teachers outside the classroom, mobilize students' learning enthusiasm and sense of participation, and design relevant teaching activities to improve the diversity of teaching content and methods.

6.4. Growth Together through Interaction

"The foreign language classroom is namely a society where students engage in simulated communication and an entity of language drills, where students are opponents of each other, goals of each other, means of each other, corrections of each other, and also influences of each other." Teachers can also find problems in their interactions with students, whether it is teaching methods or gaps in their expertise, which are worth reflecting on and correcting. 7. Conclusion

Interactive teaching mode teachers and teaching equipment have certain high requirements, part of the underdeveloped areas of education can not be popularized, and China's huge number of students and the national conditions and student personality is not necessarily applicable to interactive teaching mode, which is also the traditional "duck" mode of education is widely accepted by the degree of one of the reasons.
