# The Application of Orff Teaching Method in Children's Drama Education in China

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### Abstract

This paper aims to explore the application of Orff teaching method in children's drama education in China. Through the introduction and analysis of Orff's teaching method, this study found that Orff's teaching method and China's children's drama education have common concepts, such as paying attention to students' autonomous learning, physical participation and creative expression. However, at present, some children's drama education in China pays too much attention to traditional drama performance skills and lacks innovation and diversity. This study believes that the application of Orff teaching method in children's drama education can solve this problem. Specifically, Orff teaching method can guide children's singing and dancing expression, encourage role-playing and scene simulation, promote children's creation and adaptation of scripts, and enrich performances with music and rhythm. Through these teaching methods, children can fully develop and cultivate their artistic expression ability, creativity, cooperation spirit and self-confidence. This study holds that educators should actively integrate Orff's teaching method into children's drama education in China, so as to promote children's all-round artistic development and cultivate their aesthetic ability.

### 1. Introduction

"Dig, dig, dig in a small garden ..." A light and pleasant short video is popular in China's major short video platforms, which has reached 242.45 billion times by June 21st, 2023, and the blogger "Music teacher is full of flowers and wealth" has gained 7.94 million, which has caused many netizens to imitate and re-create. The teaching method adopted in this short video once again introduces the public's vision, that is, Orff teaching method.

Orff teaching method is a comprehensive teaching method founded by German music educator Carl Orff, aiming at promoting students' all-round development through music, dance, drama and creation. This teaching method emphasizes students' autonomous learning, physical participation and creative expression, and stimulates students' imagination, creativity and expressive ability through interesting and challenging learning activities.

China's children's drama education refers to the educational activities carried out through drama art forms, aiming at children's characteristics and needs. It aims to cultivate children's creativity, expressive ability, cooperative spirit and self-confidence and promote their all-round development.

There is a common concept between China's children's drama and Orff's teaching method. Orff's teaching method also emphasizes teaching in the form of chorus and group dance to cultivate children's cooperative spirit and team consciousness. Children learn to listen and cooperate in group performances, coordinate their movements and voices with each other, and cultivate good communication and cooperation skills.

Orff's teaching method plays an important role in guiding children's singing and dancing expression, which provides beneficial guidance and support for children's all-round artistic development by creating a positive learning environment, cultivating artistic interest, developing music perception and expression ability, enhancing self-awareness and self-confidence, and promoting cooperative spirit and team consciousness.

### 3. Encourage Role-playing and Scenario Simulation

Orff's teaching method emphasizes promoting children's comprehensive development through physical participation and emotional experience, and role-playing and scenario simulation are one of the commonly used teaching strategies in Orff's teaching method. Role-playing and scenario simulation can stimulate children's creativity and imagination. By playing different roles and simulating various situations, children can expand their thinking and imagination, experience different people and situations, and cultivate their artistic expression ability and creative thinking. In this process, children are involved in different emotional experiences and show their emotions through body language, language expression and performance. This helps children to express and understand all kinds of emotions, and cultivate emotional wisdom and emotional management ability. Role-playing and scenario simulation can put children in a comprehensive learning situation. By simulating scenes and roles in real life, children can learn skills and knowledge in many dimensions, such as language, emotion and social interaction, and promote their all-round development.

Blogger "Music teacher is full of flowers and wealth" introduced Orff teaching method into public view, and more and more people began to understand and learn Orff teaching method. However, the survey shows that there are still 57% kindergartens that have not offered Orff music courses. It is an arduous task with a sense of mission to integrate Orff's music teaching method, an excellent teaching system widely accepted worldwide, and it is also the responsibility of our educators.

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
