For students, interest has a great impact on them. If students are interested in something, it will encourage them to invest more energy in it. On the contrary, if students lack interest in something, it will be difficult to attract them to actively participate, and even lead to their rejection psychology. In classic recitation, some teachers simply list the reading content and lack screening, which will lead to the lack of attraction of the reading content to students, making classic recitation a boring activity for students, and thus reducing the effectiveness of reading.

3.2. Parents' participation in home-school cooperative education is insufficient

Parents play a very important role in students' extracurricular reading, and if there is a lack of parental demonstration and guidance, it will reduce students' enthusiasm for participation. This simple model made students unwilling to participate and even generated strong resistance. Due to students passively accepting the teacher's arrangements, this leads to poor reading results and even makes them gradually tired of reading books, which can have an impact on their development. In the process of reciting classics, the recitation environment is very important. A good reading environment can enable

Schools can emphasize the important role of home reading in children's development in the competition, and encourage parents to read with their children at home and share their reading experiences.

4.1.2. Establish a WeChat group for parents

Teachers, as the main guides and educators of students, should establish WeChat groups so that parents and teachers can communicate their children's learning Xi and reading progress at any time. Through the feedback of parents, teachers can keep abreast of children's learning situation, find problems and solve them. Parents can also keep abreast of the school's education and teaching situation and maintain good interaction with teachers. In this way, the effectiveness of home-school cooperation can be enhanced, and the academic Xi growth of students can be jointly promoted

4.2. At the parent level

4.2.1. Understand students' reading through teachers

First, parents can communicate with teachers on a regular basis. In this way, parents can keep track of their students' reading progress and at the same time ask teachers questions about their child's Xi. In this way, parents can better understand the education and teaching situation of the school and maintain good communication with teachers. At the same time, it can also promote the effect of home-school cooperation, so that parents can better understand the school's teaching plan and teaching progress.

4.2.2. Establish a family reading group

In the activity, teachers can guide students to discuss and share reading, and encourage parents to participate in the classroom. In this way, the family reading atmosphere can be enhanced, and children can feel the support and encouragement of their parents. At the same time, it can also promote communication and exchange between parents and children, and enhance parent-child affection.

In summary, extracurricular reading is an indispensable part of Chinese teaching in primary school, and it can improve students' reading level, enhance students' understanding of Chinese culture, and enable them to experience the charm of Chinese culture. Therefore, teachers and
